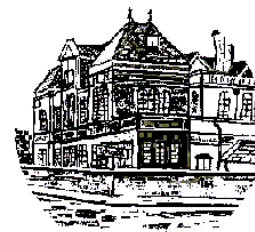

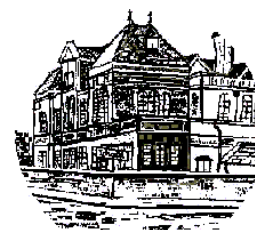

Who qualifies for 30 hours free childcare?

30 hours free childcare is available to the parents of all children aged 3 or 4 years old where the parents meet the following criteria:

- Both parents are working (or the sole parent is working in a lone parent family). And each parent earns, on average:
 - A weekly minimum equivalent to 16 hours at National Minimum Wage (NMW) or National Living Wage (NLW); and
 - Less than £100,000 per year.

(NB parents means a person who has parental responsibility for the child or care of the child. In cases where a parent has remarried or is living with a partner, the step-parent or partner must also meet the earnings threshold. Foster carers are eligible for the extended entitlement if they meet the criteria for their own children. Foster carers are not entitled to claim the offer for children that they foster. Working includes self-employed persons and parents on zero hours contracts who meet the criteria).

The entitlement is also available to families who may not meet the above criteria but who meet one of the scenarios below:

- Both parents are employed but one (or both parents) is temporarily away from the workplace on parental, maternity or paternity leave;
- Both parents are employed but one (or both parents) is temporarily away from the workplace on adoption leave;
- Both parents are employed but one (or both parents) is temporarily away from the workplace on statutory sick pay;
- One parent is employed and one parent has substantial caring responsibilities based on specific benefits received for caring; or

- One parent is employed and one parent is disabled or incapacitated based in receipt of specific benefits
